OPTION 2 – VOTING BY MAIL

How will this work?

Every registered voter will receive (by mail) an application to request an absentee ballot

When will these applications be sent out?

Within the first 2 weeks of September

What if I do not want to wait for my application to request an absentee ballot to arrive in my mailbox?

Where do I return my completed absentee ballot application once it's filled out?

State of CT Official Drop Box located in back of Westport Town Hall, 110 Myrtle Street, Westport (see below)



OR...

Mail your completed applications ASAP to :

When will I receive my **OFFICIAL ABSENTEE BALLOT** from the Town Clerk's Office?

They will be mailed out starting **October 2** OR you can make an in-person appointment with the Town Clerk's office to receive your official absentee ballot by calling 203-341-1110

How will I receive my **OFFICIAL ABSENTEE BALLOT**?

2 Options are available:

1) It will be mailed to the address you provided (on your submitted application request form) after your **APPLICATION** to request an **ABSENTEE BALLOT** has been processed by the Town Clerk's Office

OR

2) You can call the Westport Town Clerk's Office at 203-341-1110 to schedule an in-person appointment. On the day of your appointment, you will meet a Town Clerk's Office representative by the rear Town Hall entrance under the tent to pick up your **OFFICIAL ABSENTEE BALLOT**

Where do I return my completed absentee ballot?

State of CT Official Ballot Drop Box located in back of Westport Town Hall, 110 Myrtle Street, Westport (see below)



OR..

Mail your completed absentee ballot (in the included postage-paid envelope) ASAP to:

What is the postmark date that the absentee ballot needs to have in order to be counted?

Postmarks do not matter. The absentee ballot **must** be returned to the Town Clerk's office **no later than 8:00pm Nov 3rd** (Election Day). The State of CT Official Ballot Drop Box (pictured above) will be open until 8:00pm on Nov 3rd for your convenience.

Do you time and date stamp the absentee ballots that are returned in the Official Absentee Ballot Box?

Yes.

How often does the State of CT Official Ballot Drop Box located in the rear of Town Hall get emptied?

Daily. When election day gets closer, it will be twice a day.

What if you mailed in your absentee ballot via USPS or deposited it in the State of CT Official Ballot Drop Box and are not sure it has been received? Is there any way to track it?

Yes, you can verify return of your ballot on the state voter registration lookup page:

<https://portaldir.ct.gov/sots/LookUp.aspx>

On this page, you will be able to see if your absentee ballot was received by the Town Clerk. If it does not say that your absentee ballot was received on this page, then your absentee ballot has not yet been received and you should contact your Town Clerk.
